

USER INSTRUCTIONS

ADJUSTING THE FRAME

Because our products are made of natural materials and are handcrafted, each ceramic bowl has its own unique shape. Therefore, your YAKINIKU® Kamado may not fit exactly into its frame.

If you notice that the bottom of the Kamado does not come to rest on the felt of the frame, but “hangs” on the top support, you can adjust the frame to its second setting. To do this, use a crosshead screwdriver. The steps below describe how to do this.

1.

When you assemble your frame according to the assembly instructions, this is the starting point.



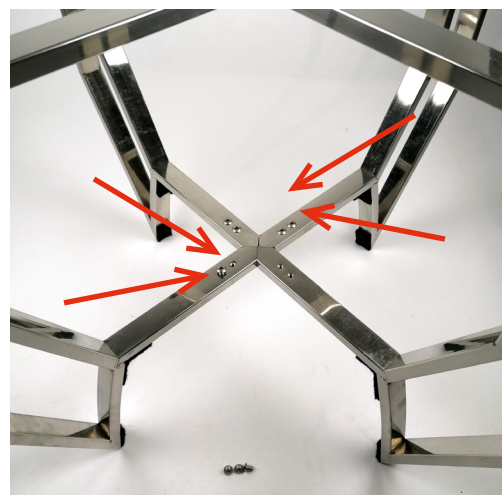
2.

Turn the frame over. Place it on a soft surface so that the points of the frame cannot be damaged.

Remove the four screws from the closest frame parts.



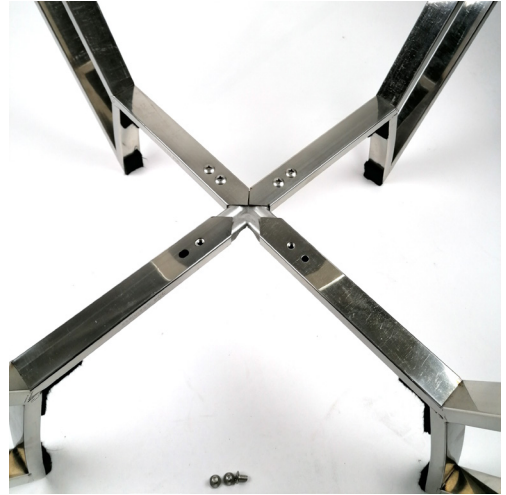

Now pull out one of the two legs so that it shifts by one hole.



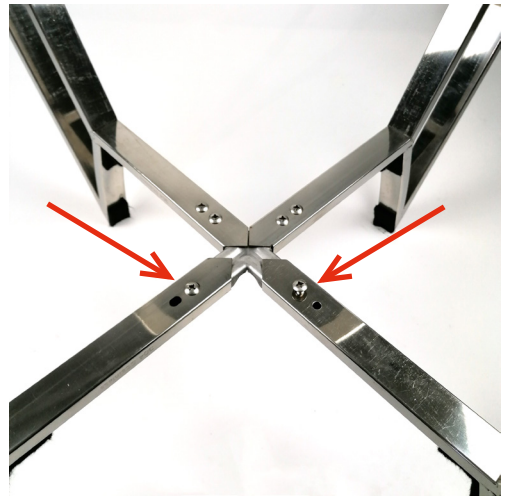

Now pull out the second leg so that it shifts by one hole.

Screw **two screws** into the inner holes. You have two screws left. These are no longer needed.

When you turn the frame around, the Kamado is given enough space to fit neatly into the frame with the right support.
